



# Design of the Garden Courtyard

Naunynstrasse 2-3 and 5-11, Waldemarstrasse 86-102 (even house numbers), Mariannenstrasse 51-53 and Mariannenplatz 7-9A

We had extensively refurbished the buildings at Waldemarstrasse 86/88 and 96–102, Naunynstrasse 6–11, Mariannenstrasse 51 and 52 and Mariannenplatz 9A as of the end of 2023. Starting next year, we will also be beautifying parts of the inner courtyard for you. The courtyard should remain a place where you can meet and spend time with your neighbours in the future.

#### Schedule

#### Planning

#### **March 2023**

• Cataloguing of the necessary improvements and repairs in the inner courtyard by degewo

#### January 2025

• Start of underground car park examination

#### May 2025

• Commissioning and start of planning by GAST landscape architects for the initial planning of the improvements and repairs

#### August 2025

• Review and incorporation of the ideas and requests from the information and participation event into the planning process

#### Autumn 2025

• Tendering and awarding of contracts for the realisation of the planning by a planning and construction company

#### As of spring 2026 (projected)

• Start realisation of planning for courtyard design in the inner courtyard



We will notify you in good time about the most important planning and construction steps and of any possible restrictions in the inner courtyard.

#### Participation

#### February 2024

• Meeting with degewo Mariannenplatz Tenants' Advisory Council for deliberations on initial thoughts for courtyard design

#### **June 2025**

- Presentation of courtyard design concept to degewo Tenants' Council and Mariannenplatz Tenants' Advisory Council
- Sending of information letter and invitation to information and participation event
- Start of digital participation: Ideas can be submitted around the clock, e.g. via mobile phone or tablet

#### **10 July 2025**

 Information and participation event in the inner courtyard

• Information brochure on the results of the information and participation event

#### Spring 2026

• Information tours about the planning and results of the participation in the inner courtyard







## Repairs and Improvements

We have compiled a list of the areas requiring repairs and where we would like to make improvements. The aim is to enhance the attractiveness of your inner courtyard and adapt it to meet the challenges of climate change.

#### Landscaping of building walls





- Install climbing aids
- Create plant beds
- Plant climbing plants

#### Beautify dustbin area





- Install climbing aids and set out plants
- Plant climbing plants or hedges

#### Unseal surface area



- Pave only the required surface
- Make areas greener

#### Improve path



- Clear the view
- Prune shrubs
- Replant some areas

#### Replant beds



- New plants
- Remove edging

#### Improve playgrounds





- Better playing surface
- New equipment and more shade
- Move bicycle stands

#### Note: The planned measures are summarised here in a highly simplified form.



#### Improve plants in the entrance area



- Thin out excessively dense plants
- New shrubs with flowers and berries

#### Seating & Safety

As we want to make the inner courtyard an even more attractive place for people to spend time, we would like to find out where additional seating and meeting points would be useful. We are also interested to know if there are any areas in the courtyard where you feel uncomfortable and what the reasons for this might be.



#### **Protecting the Climate**

We would like to know where you think having more shade or greenery would make the inner courtyard more climate and environmentally friendly. We also want to hear where there are no dustbins or where you would like a stand where you can leave your bike safely.



#### **Sports & Games**

The inner courtyard offers plenty of space to play, exercise and do sports. We want to know what equipment that would add to everyone's enjoyment in exercising is still missing here.



#### Gardening

There are already several planters in the inner courtyard—do you perhaps use one? We want to become acquainted with all the gardeners and find out who is interested in doing their gardening with others or becoming part of a gardening group.








### You can find us at these locations today

- C degewo dialogue stand


What would you like to do in the inner courtyard? What equipment for these activities is missing?
